1. Classes

Minimum of ten entries, at closing date, to constitute a class.
Cancellation of a class failing to meet the minimum entry will be at the clubs discretion.

There will be no oversubscribed fields. Only the first 24 paid entries per class will be accepted.

If a gap is needed between classes a request **must** be given to the Race Secretary at the time of entry, before closing date, & we will try to accommodate.

The race order will not be changed under any circumstances after the closing date

- 2. Entry Fees** \$120.00 per class entered. Entry Fee Includes Ambulance Fee. Late entries - \$200.00 per class entered
- 3. Closing Dates** Entries Close 8pm Sunday 10th January, 2010
Late entries accepted at the clubs discretion up to 8pm Sunday 17th January, 2010
There will be NO entries taken on the day.
- 4. Scrutineering** Scrutineering Declaration Cards must be completed and handed in at entry confirmation.
When requested, competitors are to present their kart to the scrutineers.
- 5. Transponders** Competitors shall use their KartSport New Zealand AMB TranX 160 transponder.
KartSport Auckland has a limited number of transponders available for hire at a cost of \$40.00 for the meeting.
Competitors hiring a club unit will be required to sign a hire agreement. Please indicate on your entry if you require to hire a transponder. Transponders **must** be fitted and functioning for all tuning runs & racing.
- 6. Noise Control** Non metallic inserts must be fitted between or through barrel & head fins of
all engines except Cadet. Noise meter readings will be strictly adhered to.

7. Race Format

One meeting of eight races run over the two days. Drivers **MUST** compete on Day 1 to be eligible to compete on Day 2.

Seven Heat KartSport New Zealand Pre-determined Grid Draw plus Final.

Day 1 – Saturday Four heats.

Day 2 – Sunday Three heats. Heat 8 [Final] – lowest points from both days to front.

At the conclusion of the final, worst performance over both days is dropped providing class winners. ie: seven heats count.

The National Points System will be used - 1 point for 1st, 2 points for 2nd, 3 points for 3rd etc
Ties & DQ's as per KartSport New Zealand Dirt Championship Rules.

Minimum number of laps per race will be 10. This may be changed at the clubs discretion dependent on individual class numbers.

Please be aware that failing to confirm your entry on time will result in you starting all pre-determined gridded heats from the rear of the field.
